

## Aperture Questions:

- 1) f/2.8 has a larger aperture hole.
- 2) f/5.6 has a small - medium hole. Which could be used to focus on two close people.
- 3) F in F stop means focus.
- 4) If you wanted to change the aperture to let in the least amount of light, you would want to set it at f/16.
- 5) If you wanted to change the aperture to let in the most amount of light, you would want to set it at f/2.8
- 6) If you used f/32 your picture would really be focused on everything, not just one object.
- 7) If you used f/ 1.4 your focus would be almost off, barely focused.
- 8) If you wanted to capture something that was moving, you would want to use 1/125.
- 9) If you wanted to create a blur using shutter speed, you would want to use 4/1.
- 10) You should use a tripod when using 1/125 so you don't shake which is something very common when using high shutter speed.
